Our metallic foil cases are becoming ever more popular. We stock a range of colours illustrated below with new designs of paper cases such as leopard print and floral print available.

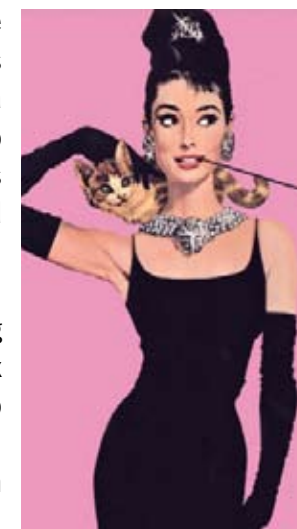


### Wedding trends, colours and venues
